The CBIS certification is developed and administered through the Brain Injury Association of America and the requirements to sit for the exam is a high school education and 500 hours of supervised experience working with brain injury.

**Cost:** \$235 for the two-day class, access to North Dakota Brain Injury Network's (NDBIN) study portal, exam, and one-year subscription to the *Journal of Head Trauma Rehabilitation*. Cost of the textbook (*Essential Brain Injury Guide*) is \$135.
